Bargaining Update

The first face-to-face bargaining session took place Sept. 25 - 27, 2018, with the next scheduled for February 5th to 7th. Both PIPSC and TB exchanged bargaining proposals (which can be viewed on the PIPSC website).



Common issues that PIPSC would like to discuss include: pay rules, family leave, workplace harassment, family day, duration of agreement and economic increase.
